CE Workshop Getting Comfortable with Prescribing Scleral GP Contact Lenses

Technological advances in GP lens materials and lens fabrication methods have enabled eyecare practitioners to successfully prescribe scleral contact lens designs. These lenses vault the cornea and rest on the sclera allowing even the most extreme corneal irregularity case to be fit successfully.

At SCCO's Eye Care Center, we have embraced scleral lenses and have utilized them in the treatment of many of our patients requiring specialty designs or suffering from dry eye symptoms. Lectures will be followed by live video scleral grand rounds and a workshop on scleral lens application, removal, care, and fitting evaluation.
